If your original RPL application was unsuccessful you can apply for an appeal and include additional details or relevant previous experience for reassessment.

The NTT RPL appeals application form has two parts; part A is the candidate information section that you complete once only and part B must be completed for each Unit of Competency you want to appeal.

E.G. If you are appealing RPL for two Units of Competency then you complete part A once and complete part B two times, once for each subject documenting the additional evidence you are submitting for that subject.
